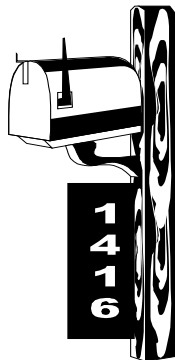

Fish Fry Dedicated to Men of Community

The Bloom Township Fire fighters would like to honor three men who improved Bloom Township with their service and dedication.

Mr. "Jim" Benson served in the U.S. Navy. He had owned and operated Law and Benson Olde Country store for decades. Jim had driven a school bus for Bloom-Carroll Schools for 39 years and retired as fire chief of the Bloom Township Volunteer Fire Department after 24 years.

Mr. Harold W. "Bill" Stebelton along with his wife Theo has been a pillar of the community for many, many years. Bill was born in Bloom Township on December 27, 1923. He was a rural mail carrier for the Canal Winchester Post Office for 37 years, and was a 30-year volunteer for the Bloom Twp. Fire Department. Bill attended Lithopolis United Methodist Church.

Mr. Barry Black was a member of the Ohio and National Pork Producers and PGI Group, as well as an active supporter of 4-H and the Bloom-Carroll FFA, with his daughters. He was a member of the Marcy Trinity Lutheran Church and also attended the Lithopolis United Methodist Church. Barry and his family have always been strong members and/or supporters of the Bloom Township Fire Department.

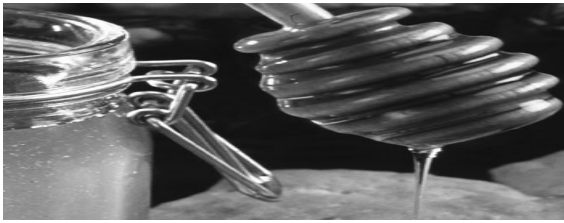

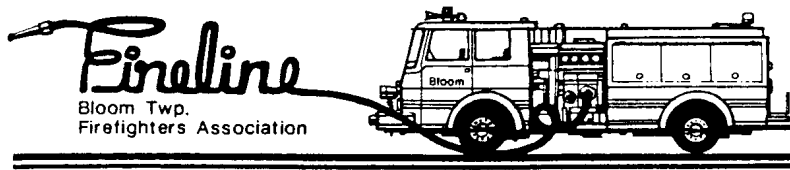
