Joseph Smith, Chairperson, called the meeting to order. Members present were Joseph Smith and Larry Coyle. David Petty was absent due to a work obligation. Diana Uther of the Fairfield County Health Department was also present in addition to a representative from the Fairfield County Engineers Office and several interested citizens. The purpose of the special meeting was to meet with neighbors of the Alspach and Sitterley Road area regarding drainage issues. Jerrold Schwarz, township attorney, was present to advise the board. Smith led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

In the absence of Carol Moore, Clerk, Smith moved to appoint Larry Coyle to take the minutes, seconded by Coyle. Motion passed 3-0.

Discussion regarding drainage issues at the Alspach and Sitterley Road area: All agreed a drainage issue exists and discussed ways to remedy the situation. ~~While the township possesses no liability in the issue,~~ it is the board's desire to cooperate in any manner feasible to remedy the problem. A representative of the engineer's office will draw up plans and necessary surveys to address the issue. The issue will be discussed further at a future board of trustees meeting.
